



Junior Police Academy

The Mount Laurel Police Department is recruiting candidates for our second annual Junior Police Academy. The Academy is open to qualified boys and girls interested in law enforcement, who are currently in the 6th or 7th grade. This five-day course will include various presentations on law enforcement topics, hands on practical scenarios, instruction in military drill and physical fitness training. The objective is to provide a week of education and fun through a police academy format to the youth of our community. The Junior Police Academy will be held at the Harrington Middle School, 514 Mount Laurel Road, Mount Laurel, NJ from Monday August 14, 2017 to Friday August 18, 2017 between the hours of 7:30 AM – 3:00 PM.

Seating is limited to 20 students. Applications are extended to a due date no later than April 19, 2017. Applications must include a letter of recommendation from a school representative such as a teacher, guidance counselor, etc. Completed applications can be returned to Mount Laurel Police Department Headquarters, 100 Mount Laurel Road, Mount Laurel, NJ, attention: Lt Judy Lynn Schiavone. Applications received after the above listed date will be subject to disqualification. All applications will be time and date stamped as they are received. Applicants who successfully complete a thorough background check will be placed on a list with preference given to 7th grade students. Applicants who are not accepted into the first 20 seats will be placed on a standby list. Candidates accepted into the academy will be notified the week of April 24, 2017.
